

Uniform Dress Policy

Christ Lincoln Schools has established a uniform dress policy for all students Kindergarten through Fifth Grade. Please refer to the Elementary School Uniform Guide on the back. Students will need to follow this policy on all school days unless otherwise notified of a non-uniform day. New students just transferring into the school will have a one-week transition period before uniforms are required.

Requirements for All

- All students will be required to have at least one navy or green Christ Lincoln Schools logo shirt. (Dennis Uniform brand only)
- Shirts must have a collar; such as polo shirt, turtleneck, button down oxford style, or peter pan style (Girls), Shirts need to be tucked into pants, shorts and skorts/skirts.
- Socks or (tights/leggings) must be worn. Must be solid white, navy, black, gray or hunter green. (No patterns)
- Shoes must be closed toed and closed heel. No crocs or clogs. Tennis shoes will be required for physical education classes.
- Belts are optional. If belts are worn, they should be black, brown, khaki or navy.
- Hats may not be worn in the school building.
- No pierced body parts other than earrings.
- No unnaturally colored hair (such as purple or green).
- Hairstyle must not cover the eyes.
- Jewelry should be worn modestly and in good taste.
- Undershirts, whether short or long, must be solid white, navy, black, gray or hunter green.
- Pants that are torn must be mended. (Note: Dennis Uniform will replace their pants that have torn knees with another pair in the same size.)
- Shorts & pants should be straight leg without pockets on the outside.
- Outerwear worn in classrooms should be solid color-white, navy, hunter green, gray or be Christ Lincoln Schools specific items sold by Dennis Uniform or TAG Uniform Wear, available when the Spirit Store is open multiple times throughout the school year. Items in the above approved categories may include cardigans, quarter-zips, full zip sweatshirts/fleece/vests, crew neck or hoodie sweatshirts.
- Outerwear worn outside may be of any color or design.
- Girls that wear jumpers or skirts without the built-in shorts are required to wear a separate pair of shorts underneath (approved colors listed with leggings/tights/socks).
- Khaki or navy jeggings are only allowed under jumpers or skirts. (Same with denim leggings/jeggings on Spirit Day.)
- Girls are encouraged to wear shorts under skirts for warmth during recess and modesty during physical education classes.
- While make-up is not encouraged, it may be worn subtly.

SHIRTS

Solid Navy or Hunter Green Polo with CLS embroidered logo - available only through Dennis Uniform

OR

Solid white polo or button up shirt/blouse with no logo - purchased from Dennis Uniform or anywhere.

Shirts should be worn tucked in at all times.

Undershirts should be solid color - white, navy, black, grey, hunter green.



BOTTOMS/JUMPERS

Solid Khaki or Navy pants, shorts, skorts, and jumpers - available through Dennis Uniform or anywhere.

[Material should not be lycra/stretch or jean-like]

Campbell Plaid skorts and jumpers - available only through Dennis Uniform.

Leggings or biker shorts worn under skorts should be solid color - white, navy, black, grey, hunter green.

Length on all shorts and skorts should be no shorter than fingertips when arms are held down at sides.



CLASSROOM OUTERWEAR

Outerwear worn in classrooms should be solid color - white, navy, hunter green, grey or be Christ Lincoln Schools specific items sold by Dennis Uniform or TAG Uniform Wear - available when the Spirit Store is open multiple times throughout the school year.

Items in the above approved categories may include cardigans, quarter-zips, full-zip sweatshirts/fleece/vests, crew neck or hoodie sweatshirts.

Outerwear worn outside may be of any color or design.



Socks/Tights - must be solid color - white, navy, black, grey, hunter green with no patterns.

Belts are optional. If worn, should be black, brown, khaki, or navy.

Any girls hair accessory meeting school standards can be worn.

Headbands must be flat and not stand higher than 1" from the top of the head.

No distracting bands - including flowers, cat ears, unicorns, tiaras, etc. are to be worn.

Shoes - should be closed toed and closed heel.

No sandals, crocs, or clogs.

Tennis shoes should be worn on P.E. days.



Non-Uniform Days

Free/Theme Dress Days occur periodically. We depend on parents to monitor what the children wear on non-uniform days. Clothing must be appropriate to school activities and must be neatly hemmed. The following are not allowed: sleeveless shirts for boys, “spaghetti straps,” tank tops with straps narrower than one inch, strapless or off the shoulder tops, clothing with holes, tears, rips, or frays; shirts with questionable sayings; leggings, jeggings, exercise pants, yoga pants, tight-fitting pants, etc. unless worn with a shirt or top that covers to mid-thigh; tight fitting shorts or tops; pajamas (except for a themed pajama day) or any other apparel deemed inappropriate by the Administration. At no time should undergarments or the midriff area be exposed. Length of shorts, skirts, dresses, etc. must follow the uniform guidelines. These guidelines also apply to school programs and concerts.
